# How to prepare for your little one's vaccination

Vaccinations keep your child safe from preventable diseases. Here's what you can do to make sure your little one's vaccination goes smoothly!



## Before the vaccination

- Make sure your child's health booklet is updated with their latest vaccinations & have their booklet with you during the appointment
- Pack your child's favourite toy or book to entertain them during their vaccination
- Speak to your little one before the appointment & let them know there's nothing to be afraid of

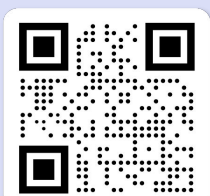
## During the vaccination

- Comfort your little one by talking and singing to them or entertain them with their favourite toy or book
- You can help the doctor by holding your child as they're getting their shot – a good position is to hold them firmly on your lap



## After the vaccination

- Let your little one know that they did a great job in being brave during the session
- You may cover the injection site with a cool, damp cloth to soothe the area
- If your child has flu-like symptoms, you can give them medication such as paracetamol or ibuprofen. Consult your doctor for how much you should provide them with.
